Tuition & Scholarships

Parishioner Scholarship - A scholarship of \$1,300 per student for families giving time, talent or treasure. Great opportunity for those to volunteer to qualify for this scholarship.

Angel Scholarship - We raised \$93k for our Angel Fund last year and funds must be fully allocated back to St. Barnabas families. Priority goes to low income, but now many low income families are helped in full by EdChoice.

EdChoice Expansion Scholarship - Income based on a sliding scale. Every family who applies will receive a scholarship of at least \$650 per child.

HOW DID THE EDCHOICE SCHOLARSHIP CHANGE MY TUITION

EdChoice Expansion was adopted by St. Barnabas in July of 2023

Before EdChoice

TUITION

Base tuition was \$6,050



MULTI-FAMILY DISCOUNT AND KINDERGARTEN RATE

Multiple students reduced the rate of tuition (~\$500 discount) and Kindergarten was \$5,500

SCHOLARSHIPS

\$93,000 in **Angel Scholarship Funds** were distributed to families who may have needed assistance to reduce tuition fees. **Parishioner Tuition Scholarship** funded by the parish reduced tuition fees (about **\$1,300** per student if applicable).

After EdChoice

TUITION

The tuition policy was adjusted to cover the full amount of the scholarship - **\$6,500**

MULTI-STUDENT DISCOUNT AND KINDERGARTEN RATE

The multi-student discount was removed Kindergarten was raised by \$6,165 (increase by \$665)

SCHOLARSHIPS

Because EdChoice will support those families who qualify, SBS now has **\$93,000** back from the **Angel Fund** to help close the gap for families who no longer have the multi-student discount or Kindergarten rate.

Families must apply for both the Angel Scholarship and EdChoice Scholarship regardless of financial status.

The Parishioner Scholarship (\$1,300)

is still available for those who apply.

No family will pay more tuition fees than originally agreed upon in the 2023 tuition policy if applied for EdChoice Expansion AND Angel Scholarship. **The deadline is September 8, 2023.**






